Initially founded as the Women's Choral Society in 1919, Reading Community Singers is one of the oldest continuously running nonaudition community choruses in the country.

With a herculean effort, we were able to maintain this distinction during the pandemic by rehearsing via Zoom and performing virtually through YouTube Livestream with the help of music engineer, Chris Rogers. Thanks to our generous donors, RCS was able to afford the technology and sound equipment to do this. 
